



Applying for Pupil Premium at Carlyle Infant and Nursery School

Please sign up for Pupil Premium if you think your child may be entitled.

Please speak to us if you have any problems with money for uniform, trips or clubs. The Pupil Premium grant is available for children who are from low-income families, in care or if their parent is currently serving in the armed forces. Please see further details below:.

You can claim for Pupil Premium if you currently receive:

- Income Support
- Income-based jobseekers allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax credit, providing you aren't entitled to Working Tax Credit, and have an annual household income (as assessed by HM Revenue and Customs) that does not exceed £16,190.

How can my child be supported through pupil premium?

- Children who are eligible for pupil premium funding are given the opportunity to work on their own or in small groups .
- To engage the children's interests we will be giving them the opportunity to be a part of the "Snowy Owls Club".
- During their time with the Snowy Owls Club they will be given the opportunity to take part in activities to support them academically, socially and emotionally.
- These children are offered a place on a school trip for free.
- We can supply some School uniform for free.
